| Note the striking prophetic parallels: The above description combines in an unmistakable way the dual nature of the Antichrist (<i>Presentation #4</i>): violent opposition against Jesus (little horn of Dan. 7) and subtle substitution for Jesus (sea beast of Rev. I3). Therefore, to identify end-time Babylon is to identify the Antichrist power foretold in Daniel 7 that would resurge at the end of time as foretold in Revelation I3. | Revelation 14:4—God invites us to respond to the truth of His Word by following the Lamb <u>wherever</u> He leads. |
