The Real Issue

- ❑ Revelation 14:7, 9-11—God’s end-time message makes a passionate appeal to _____ the true God and strongly warns against receiving the mark of the beast.

In order to correctly identify the mark of the beast, we must understand its underlying issue in the context of true or false _____. Though many ideas exist about what the mark of the beast will be, the real issue is not about tattoos and computer chips. The real issue is who we really worship. God is calling for people who will worship Him in spirit and in truth (John 4:23), those who keep His commandments and the faith of Jesus (Rev. 14:12).
