It seems to me that we face one of two basic choices: either God planted these differences in Scripture as some final test to see if we could believe in spite of what we see on the pages, or he allowed the writers of Scripture to incorporate these differences as a means of expressing their own experience in the things of God, thus enriching our lives through what we read on its pages.²

Telling God how he should have done it will not change the Bible. It is too late for that. We have to live with it as it is.³

Brethren, cling to your Bible, as it reads, and stop your criticisms in regard to its validity, and obey the Word, and not one of you will be lost. ⁴




